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The file on the magnetoplumbite group in CNMNC Newsletter 54 was wrong in the following details: general formula and name of one of the subgroups. Here is the correct version.

Magnetoplumbite group

The magnetoplumbite group has been established; it currently includes 11 mineral species. Minerals of the magnetoplumbite group have the general formula $AB_{12}O_{19}$. The group is divided into subgroups, based on the dominant *A* cation: magnetoplumbite subgroup ($A = \text{Pb}$), hawthorneite subgroup ($A = \text{Ba}$), and hibonite subgroup ($A = \text{Ca}$). Hibonite-(Fe) has been renamed chihuahuaite.
